Symptoms

Pockets food
Problems with chewing
Refusing to eat or drink
Takes a long time to eat
Overfills mouth while eating
Coughs or gags while eating
Trouble breathing while eating
Not gaining weight or growing
Picky eating and/or limited diet
Eats only certain textured foods
Spits up or throws up during meals
Drools and/or looses food while eating

Treatment

Improving postural control
Trying new food and drinks
Helping with sensory issues
Developing primary reflexes
Developing tongue movement
Education on environmental cues
Family involvement with therapies
Improving muscle strength of mouth
